There was a small increase in both sheep and lamb numbers. The quality of the lambs was mostly good with a small number of well finished young lambs available. The quality of the old lambs varied with condition also mixed. All regular buyers were in attendance.

The market for young lambs was firm. The older lambs realised a firm to dearer market for the better quality trade and heavy weights by \$2 to \$4/head. There were some sales of secondary quality trade lambs that realised a cheaper trend.

There was an improved quality offering of wethers in a mixed quality offering of grown sheep. The market showed a firm to dearer trend, with the quality of the offering also contributing to some of the price variations.
